Introduction

Discover the world of Artificial Intelligence and its growing impact on business and internal audit. Across two interactive days, participants will explore how AI works, how it learns, the evolution of Generative AI, and the practical capabilities of ChatGPT and other LLM tools. Through live demonstrations, hands-on workshops and real-world challenges, participants will develop effective prompting skills and explore practical AI use cases.

The second day takes a deeper dive into **AI for Internal Audit**, covering advanced prompting, LLM tool comparison, AI business value, AI-related risks and the **AI Canvas**. Participants will exchange experiences, discuss the opportunities and challenges of adopting AI in audit teams, and gain practical tips for integrating AI into their work. The training also emphasizes **responsible, ethical and effective AI adoption**, helping participants look beyond the technology and towards its practical value for the future of internal audit.

This course is designed for **all Internal auditors** who are interested in the domain of AI and want to build a solid understanding, get insight on practical applications (ref. learning objectives). And are looking for ways to work effectively with tools like ChatGPT, CoPilot and are considering to introduce these practices in their daily way of working.

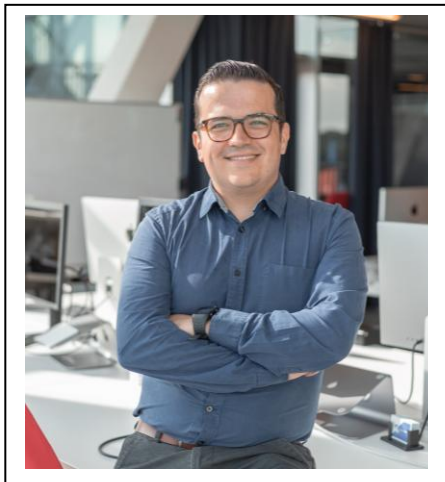
